# YOUTH TAIZÉ PILGRIMAGE



The 2024 Youth Taizé Pilgrimage is organized by Trinity Church Wall Street in collaboration with Christ's Church, Rye.

Each year, we lead a group of pilgrims to visit Taizé, a monastery in eastern France. We begin our trip by spending time together in a major European city, which changes from one year to the next. We've visited cities like Paris, Geneva, and Rome in previous years. This year, we'll be visiting Barcelona. While in Barcelona, we'll learn about the city's history and culture—and sample lots of local foods.

After a few days, we'll continue on to the monastery at Taizé. While there, we'll spend nearly a week entering into the community's rhythm of prayer, service, learning, and rest.

The Taizé Community in Burgundy, France, is made up of more than 100 brothers from over 30 countries. The Community is committed to reconciliation - between denominations, faiths, nations, and individuals. Since its founding in 1940, the monastery has become a major site of Christian pilgrimage, particularly for young people. During our trip, our youth will interact with young people from around the world as we all worship, eat, learn, and play together.

Each year, our pilgrims find opportunities to better know themselves, one another, and God.
